Drop Off / Pick Up

- **For Pick up** the school building will be closed each afternoon at 3pm. The group will arrive to Door #2 in the parking lot and be outside for pick up.

Register online via our registration portal: Community Pass. If you do not have an account, please visit our website at: www.ywcanewburyport.org. Click on "Register" and create an account.

Our online system doesn't support a 3-pronged priority registration, so all registrants will be automatically put onto a waitlist to ensure that participants are registered according to our priority schedule. Please allow for up to 1-week for your registration to be accepted. Once accepted, the system will email you and direct you to pay your tuition fees. Slots will <u>NOT</u> be held without payment. Reach out to the program director if you need information on financial assistance.
