The program complies with regulations of the Massachusetts Department of Public Health and is licensed by the local department of health.

How do I know if my child is ready for an trips program?

- I can bathroom independently.
- I can change into and out of my bathing suit by myself.
- I can walk for extended periods and stand for long stretches all while carrying my bag.
- I can sit safely in my seat on a school bus for long durations.
- I can pack my own bag and keep track of my own belongings.
- I can wait for extended periods while maintaining focus.
- I respond effectively to verbal instructions with little support or redirection.
- I am curious and excited about new experiences, flexible with a changing routine.

Inclusion Policy

The YWCA values inclusivity. We acknowledge that for safety reasons our summer trips program design requires children to be independent and self-managing within the staff/child ratio. The YWCA does not have the staffing to provide 1:1 support. We have an inclusion specialist working full time providing guidance and training to staff and ensuring strong intentional support for the group. Parents should reach out to the Youth Services Director with any/all specific support needs to ensure appropriate accommodation is available.
