YWCA Greater Newburyport Housing Choice Coalition Hosts Expert on Exclusionary Zoning

Newburyport, MA - The YWCA Greater Newburyport Housing Choice Coalition will host renowned zoning expert Amy Dain, who will present findings from her recent paper "Exclusionary by Design". Her research examines how zoning in Massachusetts has been used as a tool for racial, class and economic segregation over the past century. In her comprehensive study, Dain uncovers evidence of how zoning regulations have systematically excluded certain groups, including racial minorities, lower-income residents, and families with children from many communities in Greater Boston. Her research provides crucial historical context for understanding current housing challenges and inequities in the region.

"Amy Dain's work sheds light on the often-hidden ways zoning has shaped our communities," said Judy Tymon, Chair of the YWCA Greater Newburyport Housing Choice Coalition. "Her insights are essential for anyone interested in creating more equitable and inclusive housing policies. An understanding of zoning as a tool to separate populations according race and class is especially important today as Newburyport considers new zoning for the Brown School, the K-Mart Plaza and for accessory dwelling units."

The event is open to the public and will be of particular interest to local officials, housing advocates, and community members concerned about affordable housing and racial equity. Attendees will gain a deeper understanding of:

- How zoning has been used as a tool for exclusion throughout Massachusetts history
- The impact of exclusionary zoning on racial and economic segregation
- The connection between historical zoning practices and current housing challenges
- Potential paths forward for creating more inclusive communities
- How terms such as "community character" are used in zoning to exclude certain populations

Amy Dain is a respected researcher and consultant specializing in land use regulation and housing policy in Massachusetts. Her work has been influential in shaping discussions around zoning reform and affordable housing initiatives throughout the state.
