

school-aged childcare program description

Our multi-aged program offers a rich, engaging array of activities and experiences within a fun developmentally appropriate program model. Youth participate in making choices about how they prefer to spend their time. Activity choices include outdoor play, gym time, free play, social enrichment and themed activities. The program provides an afternoon snack.

Monthly payments are based on 10 installments of your annual contract. Monthly tuition is debited through our online registration portal, Community Pass on the 15th of the month prior to service. September tuition is drafted in August 2026 and payments end in May 2027.

The after-school program follows the NPS school calendar. If the school building is closed, then the program is also closed. The after-school program does not offer childcare for the following:

- Early Release Days*
- Staff Development Days
- Holidays –Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veteran’s Day, Thanksgiving Break, Christmas Day, New Year’s Day, MLK Day, February Break, April Break, Memorial Day & Juneteenth
- School Vacation Weeks (Christmas, February and April)*
- School closures due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances

**The YWCA may offer programming to coincide with school closures (early release days and February/April vacation weeks). Offerings are based on staffing, space availability and family needs. Offerings will be broadcast to all after-school participants as information becomes available. School's Out participants get priority in all additional programs offered.*

Enrollment Process

- **Monday, May 4, 2026 - Priority Registration** (current participants and their siblings)
 - *Current participants who will be entering K-3 will be placed into their same schedule in the upcoming school year. If you are looking to switch your schedule, you need to reach out to Amanda directly. You are guaranteed your current slot, but schedule changes are not guaranteed.*
- **Monday, May 18, 2026 – Waitlist Registration** (2025-26 waitlisted families)
 - *Amanda will reach out to you if a spot is available and/or ask you if you would like to remain on the waitlist for the upcoming school year.*
- **Monday, June 1, 2026 (9am) – General Public Registration** (new families)
 - *You can register online in Community Pass starting at 9am on June 1st. You will be able to pick your schedule or will be placed onto the waitlist.*

The YWCA does not maintain an interest/waitlist for families joining in 2026-27.

Registration is on our online registration portal (Community Pass). If you don't have a family account, you will need to set one up. You can create an account by going to our website at www.ywcanewburyport.org and clicking on the online registration button which will bring you to community pass and ask you to sign in and also allow you to create an account.

Registration is only complete when you have done the following:

1. Paid your annual registration fee in your account (non-refundable \$50)
2. Saved your financial information to your account to be set up in the autopay system which will begin on August 15th.
3. Returned your completed intake paperwork by August 1st. Keep your eyes on your email for an e-blast with forms and instructions; this typically arrives in early July.
