- I am curious and excited about new experiences, flexible with a changing routine.

We have an inclusion specialist working full time providing guidance and training to staff and ensuring strong intentional support for the group. Parents should reach out to the Program Director with any/all specific support needs to ensure appropriate accommodations are available.
